**Policing Strategy**

AMCl awaiting a public order strategy. Intelligence gathering is ongoing. Police understand there has been no announcements in the public domain.

Police do not have contact details for all. Although PCC have sent details of all the contact details they have. Police need to look at links to XR. Will be working with dynamic assessments on the day.

PCC - STRAW have a plan for the day. Police understand there is a closed WhatsApp group.

Police will carry out POPs assessment today. Likely to be low risk. This might change with intelligence on the day.

Insp James DRAKE – would be surprised if it was anything apart from low risk. Not a great deal of resources in Plymouth. At usual resource level but limited additional resource.

Understand there will be a release of information with go ahead from Council.

Paul Barnard – STRAW will mobilise at point fencing is erected 6.00pm & 7.00pm City Council should release strategic info at the point the fencing is erect. Machines should be in compound after 7.00pm. May be a highway matter. The 7.00pm. release of info needs to be ratified by Giles P – can be done electronically and automatic.

Insp JD believed this is sensible. Asking if there is any scope for machinery to be moved in beforehand?

Ray H – advising site will be a CDM site which needs to be in place before machinery on site. Probaly can't n=move machinery on site until the fence line is in. Need to clarify the powers re trespass once the barrier is in place.

Insp JD – question re route

Gavin – vehicles will park off-site – possibly Coypool or Home park. Coypool preferred. They will contact the convoy direct to allow liaison between PCC and Police

Insp JD – will look at the assessment, and cover the resources available.

Dave R – discussed potential for small groups gathering before fences go up. Sec 35?

Insp JD – must balance sec 35 action against peaceful right to protest.

Dave R / Ray H – have grey area between non-operational and CDM site will be looking at public safety issues.

Ray H – point protest activity to Sundial where they will be safe.

Concerns from PCC re spitting and abuse which has been faced in previous protest.

Insp JD – reluctant to use S35 to treat an entire group in a manner which does not reflect the minority.

AMCl – there may be people who want to view the trees going.

Ray H – security may have ability to remove people. Need to think about handover process.

Insp JD – will set up a pre-emptive log – so log can be quoted if there is an area. If there are people attaching themselves to trees or machinery. Will look to secure site and pick up in the morning.

Ray H – SMSW can remove but will need to evaluate risk of harm.

Insp JD – protesters tend to be well informed about their methods and the actions which can be taken to remove them.

Paul B – concern that money is an issue – six figure sums.

Insp JD – concerned that there is limited notice. May not have resources available.

PCC will be down to SMSW to act as security.

Ray H – will be down to fencing company to erect fence as quickly as possible.

Paul B – questioning timescale for erecting. Ray H – faster the perimeter fence is erected the better. Quickest possible chance.

Insp JD – securing site early is key.

Ray H – questions – can anyone involved send Ray H contact details. Need to brief DSFRS & SWAST since the surrounding roads are access for vehicles attending incidents.

Dave R – has updated with CCTV – Darren. Ray suggested CCTV deploy mobile units. No to early on.

Ray H – advised business will need to be advised – eg early business access. Need to have a clear message to deliver.

MI – have doubled security for the night, 2 dogs two vehicles, vulnerable points are where trees will be processed. Security will be inside compound. Doubled fencing in Mayflower Street – Cornwall St and New George Street. Areas around the German kebab will be secured after 2300. Have created a 1.5m segregation area near coach station. Will have dogs in areas if the protests look to become violent.

Have extra fencing if it is torn down. Will be able to remove people if they are trying to glue on before the glue sets

Ray H – there are unknowns around the single skinned area. SMSW advised this is supported by triangular fence units. Questions about access for emergency vehicles,

MI – advising that they have liaised with tree surgeons.

Ray H – if fire likely call 99 and advise best directing to approach.

MI – will oversee the security on the night,

Ray H requested detailed info to assemble the plan for the night with the contact info provided by SMSW

Paul B questioning use of drone – Amcl including in the police arrangements

AMcl – will pick up on Monday.

Discussion around CCTV. Use of SMSW bodycams.

Next meetings – Monday & Tuesday – Ray H to assemble OPS plan over the weekend.
